
Antenna AS-599/SPN-11, Radar Receiver-Transmitter RT-268/SPN-11

Intervals given are maximums for normal 8-hour day operation. For abnormal conditions or activities, intervals should be adjusted to compensate.

Clean fittings before lubricating. Clean parts with Solvent, dry-cleaning (SD), or with Oil, fuel, Diesel. Dry before lubricating.

CAUTION: This equipment uses high voltages that may be fatal if contacted by operating personnel. Use necessary precautions before servicing. Disconnect from power source before servicing.



Lubricant - Interval Q


Gearbox Oil Level Gage * Remove cast covers. Check level; fill to full mark

Interval - Lubricant

Gearbox Drain Plug

Remove plug and drain. Replace plug. Remove cast covers and oil level gage, and fill with three pints. Replace oil level gage and cast covers.

BLOWER UNIT (located in Radar Receiver - Transmitter RT-268/SPN-11) Blower Motor Bearings

Open hinged chassis of receiver-transmitter unit. Apply 10 drops at each bearing.

DECALCOMANIA MOUNTING INSTRUCTIONS

1. MOUNTING:

Mount on the power generator, operator's side of engine.

2. APPLICATION:

- a. Clean surface on which the decalcomania is to be applied with SOLVENT, dry-cleaning (SD), and allow to dry.
- **b.** Brush or wipe a light coating of VARNISH, spar, clear, water-resisting, or LACQUER, clear, over surface to which the decalcomania is to be applied, and allow to dry.
- c. Dip decalcomania in water until surface will separate the backing freely, then slide decalcomania into designated position.
- **d.** Slide backing paper against face of decalcomania and rub surface with a light, even pressure to eliminate air bubbles.
- e. Clean around edges of the mounted decalcomania with SOLVENT, dry-cleaning.
